
# SURVEY RESPONSE RATES

Edmunds Elementary School 2021-2022

<b>Teachers</b>	100%	N/A	<b>100%</b>
<b>Parents</b>	61%	42%	<b>60%</b>
<b>Mentees</b>	100%	100%	<b>90%</b>
<b>Mentors</b>	100%	100%	<b>100%</b>

- ✓ The program helped children read better according to:
  - **100%** of mentees
  - **100%** of teachers
  - **67%** of parents
  
- ✓ **100%** of teachers and **50%** of parents said their children showed improved (or greatly improved) vocabulary
  
- ✓ Improvement (or great improvement) in mentees' confidence in reading was reported by:
  - **60%** of mentors
  - **100%** of parents
  - **100%** of teachers

# INTEREST IN READING

Edmunds Elementary School 2021-2022

---

- ✓ **67%** of mentees said that they read more often because of reading with their mentor
  
- ✓ Mentees now are better able to talk about books and ideas, according to:
  - **100%** of teachers
  - **50%** of mentors
  - **50%** of parents
  
- ✓ Mentees now have a greater enthusiasm for reading, according to **83%** of parents

## **SCHOOL BEHAVIOR & ATTITUDES** Edmunds Elementary School 2021-2022

---

- ✓ Teachers said that **70%** of students participating in Everybody Wins! have shown improved grades/classroom performance
  
- ✓ Mentees now read more often by choice, according to:
  - **83%** of parents
  - **50%** of teachers

## **OTHER BENEFITS FROM MENTORING** Edmunds Elementary School 2021-2022

---

- ✓ Parents said that **83%** of students participating in the Everybody Wins! program feel that more adults care about them while **60%** of teachers reported the same
  
- ✓ **100%** of mentees said that their mentor was dependable
  
- ✓ **100%** of mentees said that their mentor made a positive difference in their life
  
- ✓ **100%** of mentees said that they have a strong, positive relationship with their mentor
  
- ✓ Improvement (or great improvement) in mentees' overall self-confidence was reported by **60%** of mentors

- ✓ **100%** of mentors said that Everybody Wins! met or surpassed expectations
  
- ✓ **100%** mentors said that Everybody Wins! was well organized

- ✓ Repeat participation:
  - **100%** of mentors would recommend the program to family & friends
  - **100%** of teachers would like their students to participate in Everybody Wins! again next year
